Additional Incidents and Information

Operating Under the Influence of Drugs, and Probation Violation Arrest

On July 18, 2020, at approximately 8:30 p.m., officers were advised of a possible intoxicated driver in the area of Woodward near Twelve Mile Rd. Several witnesses called 911 stating the vehicle was swerving and almost caused an accident. The officers located the vehicle at Woodward near Ten Mile and initiated a traffic stop.

The subject was identified as a 20-year-old Rochester Hills resident and found to be on probation. Officers arrested the subject for Operating Under the Influence of Drugs, and Probation Violation.

Possession of Methamphetamines, Operating Under the Influence of Drugs, Driving While License Suspended, and Felony Warrant for Probation Violation Arrest

On July 20, 2020, at approximately 7:45 a.m., officers were advised of a possible reckless driver in the area of Rochester and Thirteen Mile. Several witnesses called 911 stating the driver was crossing over the center line and swerving. The officers located the vehicle at S. Main near Eleven Mile Rd and initiated a traffic stop. Officers investigation found the driver had a suspended driver's license and a felony warrant for Probation Violation for Unarmed Robbery. The driver was also in possession of Ecstasy.

The subject was identified as a 22-year-old Clinton Township resident. Officers arrested the subject for Possession of Methamphetamines, Operating Under the Influence of Drugs, Driving While License Suspended, and Felony Warrant for Probation Violation for Unarmed Robbery.
