## **Additional Incidents and Information**

### **Felony Warrant Arrest**

On August 1, 2020, at approximately 4:30 p.m., officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at Normandy and Greenfield Rd. Officers discovered the driver had a felony warrant for his arrest from another jurisdiction.

The subject was identified as a 20-year-old Southfield resident. He was arrested for the felony warrant from Macomb County for Probation Violation for Home Invasion Third Degree.

### **Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol, Hit and Run Accident, and Violation of Bond Arrest**

On August 1, 2020, at approximately 7:00 a.m., officers were dispatched to a hit and run accident that occurred at 13 Mile Rd and Main St. The suspect drove away after striking the victim's vehicle. The driver followed the suspect's vehicle to 14 Mile and Rochester Rd. The driver of the fleeing vehicle was under the influence of alcohol and was arrested. The suspect was on a conditional bond for Domestic Violence and called her husband to pick up the vehicle.

The subject was identified as a 46-year-old Royal Oak resident. She was arrested for Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol, Hit and Run Accident, and Violation of Conditional Bond. She was prohibited for drinking alcohol and having no contact with her husband.
