Additional Incidents and Information

Felony Warrant Arrest

On November 3, 2020, at approximately 2:30 p.m., Royal Oak officers on routine patrol observed a known subject walking in the area of Crooks near 12 Mile. The officers were aware of outstanding two felony warrants for his arrest.

The 33-year-old Royal Oak resident was arrested for two felony probation violations from Oakland County Sheriff.

Carrying Concealed Weapon Arrest

On November 3, 2020, at approximately 12:10 a.m., Royal Oak officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at N. Main near Normandy. The male driver did not have a driver's license only a temporary driver's permit. The female passenger did not have any identification and gave a false name to the officers.

The 27-year-old resident of Detroit admitted to having a handgun under the driver's seat. He did not have a concealed pistol license for the firearm. He was arrested for Carrying Concealed Weapon and Violation of Temporary Permit.

The officers determined the passenger's real name and discovered she had six outstanding warrants for her arrest. The 24-year-old resident of Detroit was arrested for Obstructing Police-False Name and her outstanding warrants.
