Additional Incidents and Information

Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol and Cocaine Arrest

Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the area of Woodward near Twelve Mile. The officers spoke with the driver who smelled of intoxicants and had an open bottle of alcohol inside his vehicle. His driver's license was suspended, and he had two prior operating while intoxicated arrests. The officers observed cocaine on the driver's seat inside the vehicle. The 42-year-old Pontiac man was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated 3rd offense, Possession of Cocaine, Driving While License Suspended, and Possession of Open Alcoholic Liquor in a Motor Vehicle. The driver also had two warrants for his arrest from other jurisdictions.

Entering Without Permission Arrest

On November 20, 2020, the property manager for a vacant building located at 312 E. Third made a report for the screen being cut to the rear door to the porch. He stated nothing was taken and no one entered the main building. On November 21, 2020, officers conducted an extra check of the building and observed a male sleeping inside the screen porch. The officers are familiar with the subject who is a vagrant in the city, and he stated he was living there for a month. He was arrested for entering without permission.
