Retail Fraud

Additional Incidents and Information

Carrying Concealed Weapons and Hit & Run Suspect Arrested

On December 2020, at approximately 12:00 a.m., officers were dispatched to the area of Woodward and Lincoln for a vehicle that drove over the grass and sidewalk. The driver struck a drainage basin then drove away with his bumper dragging from the accident.

Officers checked the area and were able to locate the vehicle with a flat tire in the Detroit Zoo parking lot. The driver originally denied being in an accident. He then stated he fell asleep while driving and lost control of his vehicle.

The officers located a loaded handgun in his vehicle, and he did not have a valid permit to carry the weapon.

The 26-year-old Southfield male was arrested for Carrying Concealed Weapon and Hit & Run due to leaving the scene of an accident.

Flee & Elude, Possess Stolen Vehicle, Obstructing Police, and Felony Warrant Suspect Arrested


On December 19, 2020, at approximately 1:50 a.m., an officer in the area of 14 Mile and Coolidge, observed a vehicle matching the description from a carjacking that occurred in Southfield. The officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop and the suspect fled from the officer at a high rate of speed on westbound 14 Mile. The suspect then bailed from the vehicle and fled on foot. Officers along with K9 Jesse located the suspect hiding under a vehicle in a garage in a residential area in Beverly Hills.

The 57-year-old Southfield resident was arrested for fleeing and eluding, possession of a stolen vehicle and for a felony warrant from another jurisdiction.

On December 21, 2020, Andre Jacobs was arraigned by the Honorable Magistrate Orletski in the 44th District Court. Jacobs is charged with one (1) count of Stolen Property-Receiving and Concealing Motor Vehicle, a felony which carries a penalty of up to 5 years in prison, one (1) count of Fleeing & Eluding-Third Degree, a felony which carries a penalty of up to 5 years in prison, and one (1) count of Obstructing Police, a misdemeanor which carries a penalty of up to 93 days in jail.

Jacobs bond was set at \$15,000.00, cash/surety, 10%. His next court appearance is scheduled for December 28, 2020, at 8:30 a. m. before Judge Meinecke in the 44th District Court.

Jacobs has a lengthy criminal history including convictions for felony weapons offense, felony breaking & entering, felony stolen property, felony home invasion, felony larceny in a building, and felony dangerous drugs.
