### **Stabbing Suspect Arrested**

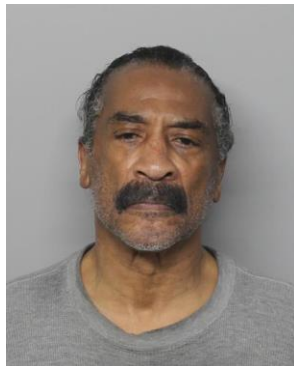
On February 27, 2021, at approximately 2:50 p.m., officers responded to a 911 call for a man who was stabbed in the area of Judson and Greenfield.

Royal Oak officers responded to the area and located a 52-year-old male with a knife wound to his back. The victim was transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The suspect, a 70-year-old male, was located and taken into custody.

Samuel Lee Bourne, Jr. was arraigned before the Honorable Magistrate Orletski of the 44<sup>th</sup> District Court. He was charged with Felonious Assault with a Dangerous Weapon, a felony which carries imprisonment of up to 4 years.

Bourne, Jr. was given a \$5,000.00 personal bond with conditions of no contact with the victim, no weapons, alcohol or drugs and must park vehicle 500 feet from victim's address.

Bourne, Jr.'s next court appearance is set for March 12, 2021 at 10:15 a.m. before the Honorable Judge Wittenberg of the 44<sup>th</sup> District Court.
