Possession of Methamphetamine, Operating While Under the Influence of Drugs, and Felony Warrant Subject Arrested

On May 8, 2021, at approximately 5:00 a.m., officers responded to the 3800 block of Elmhurst for a vehicle that struck a parked vehicle on the street. They observed a male slumped over the wheel and he appeared to be disoriented. The driver had a felony warrant for his arrest from another jurisdiction for dangerous drugs. The officers determined he was under the influence of drugs and was in possession of a small amount of methamphetamine.

The driver, a 44-year-old Ferndale resident, was arrested for Possession of Methamphetamine, and the felony warrant for Dangerous Drugs.

Reckless Driving, Leaving the Scene of an Accident and Driving While License Suspended 2nd Offense Subject Arrested

On May 12, 2021, at approximately 12:15 a.m., officers in the area of westbound I-696 and Mohawk, observed a vehicle driving at a high rate of speed on the freeway. The driver was traveling over 124 mph in a 70 mph zone.

The vehicle exited at the 10 Mile ramp and attempted to turn onto northbound Woodward. The driver lost control and struck the cement median on Woodward. The driver attempted to flee on foot and the officer was able to take her into custody.

The driver, a 40-year-old Royal Oak resident, was arrested for Reckless Driving, Leaving the Scene of an Accident, and Driving While License Suspended 2nd Offense.

Angelina Gojcay was arraigned before the Honorable Magistrate Orletski of the 44th District Court. Gojcay received a \$1,000 personal bond with conditions to not leave the state, no alcohol or drugs, drug testing, no driving a vehicle or no new crimes. Her next court date is to be determined.

Stolen Dog
