Additional Incidents and Information

Retail Fraud 2nd Offense Subject Arrested

On June 12, 2021, at approximately 7:00 a.m., officers were dispatched to CVS Pharmacy located at 30900 Woodward for retail fraud that just occurred. The clerk stated a male subject was acting suspicious inside the store.

The suspect was observed concealing bottles of cold medicine and leaving the store without paying for the merchandise.

Officers checked the area and located the subject on Woodward near Warick Ave. The male was in possession of the stolen property and was arrested.

The 44-year-old Royal Oak resident was arrested for Retail Fraud 2nd Offense and the crime was enhanced due to the conviction.

On June 13, 2021, Corey Michael Whims was arraigned before the weekend Magistrate and charged with Retail Fraud 2nd Offense, a misdemeanor punishable by up to 1 year in jail and/or a \$2,000 fine (or 3 times the value of the difference in price, property stolen, or money/property obtained, whichever is greater).

Whims has a lengthy criminal history including Felony Retail-First Degree, Misdemeanor Retail Fraud, Felony Weapons, and Felony Controlled Substance.

Whims was given a \$5,000.00 bond 10%.

Whim's next court appearance is to be determined before the Honorable Judge Meinecke of the 44th District Court.
