Additional Incidents and Information

Possession of Heroin, Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol 2nd Offense, Resisting & Obstructing, Driving While License Suspended, Misdemeanor Warrant, and Disorderly Conduct Arrest

Officers conducted a traffic stop at Woodward and Ravena. The driver who was under the influence of alcohol, gave a false name to the officers, and was also in possession of a small amount of heroin. As the officers were placing the subject under arrest, he resisted and attempted to pull away from them. The officers were able to place him in handcuffs and take him into custody. The subject had a prior operating under the influence of alcohol arrest, was driving while his license was suspended, and had several warrants for his arrest. The 28-year-old Pontiac resident was arrested on all charges.

Carrying Concealed Weapons and Narcotic Paraphernalia Arrest

Officers observed a vehicle parked near Eleven Mile and Main near a fire hydrant. The officers observed a handgun inside the vehicle. The owner of the vehicle approached the officers and stated he carries the gun for protection. The subject did not have a license to carry the gun and the weapon was unregistered. The subject was arrested and had a crack pipe in his possession. The 21-year-old Detroit resident was arrested on all charges.
