Additional Incidents and Information

Carrying Concealed Weapons and Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol Arrest

On August 4, 2021, at approximately 11:30 p.m., officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at E. Lincoln and Troy St. The driver was under the influence of alcohol and during the arrest, officers located a machete inside the vehicle.

Retail Fraud Theft 3rd Degree, Narcotic Paraphernalia, Felony and Misdemeanor Warrants Arrest

On August 3, 2021, at approximately 5:15 p.m., officer observed a suspicious male near Frenz & Sons parking lot at 1010 N. Main St. The officer spoke with the male who had an object in his waist band of his pants. The subject showed the officer the pliers he stole from the business. The employee of the store confirmed the male came into the store and asked where the pliers were located. The employee was assisting another customer and the suspect left the store without buying anything. The subject had syringes in his backpack and warrants for his arrest.
