Carrying Concealed Weapons, Driving While License Suspended, and Warrants Arrest

On September 7, 2021, at approximately 11:00 a.m., Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle and the driver's license was suspended. The driver had several warrants for his arrest and had a handgun in the glove box.

Carrying Concealed Weapons Arrest

On September 9, 2021, at approximately 12:15 a.m., Officers were dispatched to Promed Delivery Company located at 1316 N. Edison Ave., for a terminated employee sitting in his vehicle in the parking lot. Officers spoke with the male who stated he wanted to pick up his last paycheck. The employer stated his paycheck was mailed over a week ago and he wanted the him advised on trespassing.

The officers observed two 19-inch swords behind the passenger seat of the vehicle. The male told officers he carries the swords for protection.

The driver, a 52-year-old Detroit resident was advised on trespassing from the business and was arrested for Carrying Concealed Weapons.
