Operating While Intoxicated 3rd Offense, Resisting, Felony and Misdemeanor Warrants Arrest

On August 21, 2021, at approximately 11:30 p.m., officers checked the welfare of a male passed out behind the wheel of his vehicle at Washington and 11 Mile. The driver was intoxicated and had several misdemeanor and felony warrants for his arrest. While the officers were placing the driver under arrest, he began to resist and attempted to run away. He was safely secured and arrested.

The 41-year-old Detroit resident was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated 3rd Offense, Resisting, and the Felony and Misdemeanor warrants.

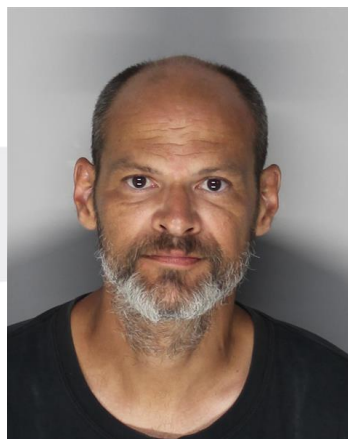
Carrying Concealed Weapon and Felony Warrant Arrest

On August 22, 2021, at approximately 5:45 p.m., officers observed a male sitting on the ground near the overpass at Ten Mile and Woodward. The officer spoke with the male who had a large double-edged hunting knife in his possession. He stated he keeps the knife for protection. The subject also had a felony warrant for his arrest.

The 47-year-old Farmington Hills resident was arrested for Carrying Concealed Weapon and a felony warrant.

On Tuesday, August 24, 2021, Jason Drum was arraigned by the Honorable Magistrate Chisolm from the 44th District Court. His bond was set for \$5,000.00 Cash/Surety, 10%. His next court appearance is scheduled for September 3, 2021, at 9:45 a.m. before Judge Wittenberg at the 44th District Court.

Drum has a criminal history including convictions for operating while intoxicated, receiving & concealing stolen goods, felony possession of controlled substance, and assault.

Indecent Exposure, Possession of Synthetic Narcotic, Resisting & Obstructing and Warrant Arrest

On August 22, 2021, at approximately 4:45 p.m., officers were dispatched to LA Fitness located at 25352 Woodward for a male exposing himself in the pool area. Management advised officers several members of the fitness club reported the subject had exposed himself to them.

The manager confronted the subject regarding the complaints, and the subject proceeded to expose himself to the manager. Officers spoke with the subject who appeared to be intoxicated. He denied the accusations and then refused to answer or listen to the officer's instructions. The subject began to resist the officers and was arrested. After the arrest, officers located unprescribed medication in his bag.

The 36-year-old Berkley resident was arrested for Indecent Exposure, Possession of Synthetic, Resisting & Obstructing, and Misdemeanor warrant arrest.

On Tuesday, August 24, 2021, Paul Clayton was arraigned by the Honorable Magistrate Chisolm from the 44th District Court. His bond was set for \$50,000.00 Cash/Surety, 10%. His next court appearance is scheduled for September 21, 2021, at 10:30 a.m. before Judge Wittenberg at the 44th District Court.
