**Carrying Concealed Weapons, Driving While License Suspended 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense, and Warrant Arrest**

On September 18, 2021, at approximately 6:45 p.m., officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at Woodward near Normandy and determined his driver's license was suspended. The driver had a warrant for his arrest and had a handgun in the driver side door.

The driver stated the handgun belonged to his mother because his gun was already confiscated from a prior arrest for Carrying Concealed Weapons.

The driver, a 26-year-old Pontiac resident was arrested for Carrying Concealed Weapons, Driving While License Suspended 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense and a misdemeanor warrant.

## **Embezzlement Arrest**

On September 21, 2021, at approximately 7:20 a.m., officers were dispatched to Speedway Gas at 1720 Rochester for an employee who stole lottery tickets. The employee was on scene and admitted to placing scratch off tickets totaling over \$486.00 in his backpack.
